

GUILDFORD TRADE SHOW BRING & BUY STAND ENTRY FORM (2024) FILLING-OUT GUIDE FOR VENDORS & T&Cs

HELP IN FILLING-IN THE ENTRY FORM

A GOGG steward is on hand at the B&B reception table.

- Items for sale must qualify as being appropriate for 7mm scale railway modelling; locos & rolling stock may only be 0-gauge.
- Stewards on the stand take every reasonable care of the items for sale, all such items being displayed, handled & offered for sale entirely at the vendors risk. The Guildford 0-gauge group and its individual members cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage howsoever caused.

RULES, INSTRUCTIONS & REQUESTS

- 1) No more than 10 lots may be submitted per individual vendor on each form
- 2) A submission charge of £5 is payable for each form. A further £5 is payable for additional forms.
- 3) Unbound magazines & periodicals will not be accepted.
- 4) Minimum asking price per lot is £5.00
- 5) Please write clearly, keeping to the lines & rows on the entry form.
- 6) List each item for sale in the designated entry form section. Use a separate row for each lot. For items being sold as a job lot, enter them as a single item.
- 7) Complete personal details, item descriptions, lot no., asking price.
- 8) Circle yes or no against q1 near the foot of the form.
- 9) The form is allocated a number by the stewards on submission.
- 10) When filled-in, the entry form must be taken by the vendor to the b&b reception desk.
- 11) Vendors may collect sales proceeds at the b&b cash desk at any time during the show. Unsold items or withdrawn items can likewise be collected. Other than the submission charge, you will receive the full proceeds of the sale of your items.
- 12) Unsold items not reclaimed by the seller will be held until alternative reclamation arrangements can be arranged, up to a time limit of three months. It is the vendor's responsibility to initiate such arrangements.
- 13) Completion of the form overleaf and offering the items for sale is taken as acceptance of the above rules, instructions, requests, terms & conditions.
- Q1: Cheque payments: most payments are in cash.
 Note that also we accept cheques with proof of identity (eg. Driving licence or guild membership card).
 We do not handle debit or credit cards as a means of payment.

THE DETACHABLE SECTION ON THE FRONT OF THE ENTRY FORM MUST BE RETAINED BY THE VENDOR AND PRODUCED/SURRENDERED WHEN COLLECTING SALES PROCEEDS/UNSOLD GOODS
