- Establishing a network of patient support groups and conferences
- Fundraising £1 million for the introduction of intra operative radiotherapy (IORT) with the UK's first mobile electron beam radiotherapy machine
- Funding full-time pancreatic, colorectal and neuroendocrine cancer PhD and MD researchers
- Helping achieve European Neuroendocrine Cancer Centre of Excellence status
- Funding hyperthermic intraperitoneal chemotherapy (HIPEC) treatment
- Funding a full-time dietitian specialising in rare cancers
